Sixteen Arts Warehouse Resident Artists Come Together to Exhibit Their Current Work in the 2023 Resident Artist Show.

Arts Warehouse is pleased to present the 2023 Resident Artist Show, a visual celebration of the unique community of Resident Artists whose work is created in their individual artist studios all located at the Arts Warehouse in Delray Beach, which is owned and operated by the Delray Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA). The exhibition is on view through January 20th, 2024 and is highlighted with a special Open Studio Night with the exhibiting Artists on January 17th, 2024, 6pm - 8pm.

The competitive Resident Artist Program at Arts Warehouse is made up of 15 artist studios with the focus of the program being supporting artists as small businesses. The annual resident artist show is an opportunity to view the diverse mediums and themes that exist within the studios showcased side by side in the front gallery at Arts Warehouse. In the exhibition viewers will see a variety of mediums including sculpture, oil painting, ceramics, and even site specific murals that will live only temporarily on the gallery walls.

Andrea Facusse, Resident Artist in her 4th year at Arts Warehouse said “These past three and a half years as a resident at the Arts Warehouse have been an incredible experience. I think that what led me to create these latest works currently exhibiting has been in part due to the exposure of creative talent I have gotten to meet at the Arts Warehouse, they are such an inspiration, so showing our work collectively in harmony is just really special to me.”

“Being a resident artist at the Arts Warehouse gave me the opportunity to experiment, and exchange ideas with fellow artists. The mixed-media installation I created for this show gave me the confidence to explore bigger and bolder ideas in the future”, shared 2nd year Resident Artist, Dominique Denis.

“The space came alive, the walls could speak once more, the art all around was witness of our love for what we do... it is us , it is we , it is what it is “, said Martha Dominguez, Resident Artist in her 2nd year at Arts Warehouse.

The significance of the group exhibition is that each artist is represented on a wall or area of the gallery space, so the viewer can immerse into each artist’s style while also viewing how they correspond to the other artists displayed. It acts as a metaphor for the creativity happening within and surrounding the individual studios. The high quality of work exhibited is a testament to the level of the resident artists at Arts Warehouse.

About Arts Warehouse:

The Delray Beach Community Redevelopment Agency rehabilitated warehouse is located on Artist Alley in the Pineapple Grove district and opened in late 2017. Arts Warehouse offers rotating art exhibitions in three gallery spaces, art workshops held throughout each month, and special event programming. Arts Warehouse encourages community growth and empowerment through engagement with local artists, residents, and community members. The 15,000 sq. ft. space is a catalyst for economic development and growth within the Pineapple Grove Arts District and the community.
